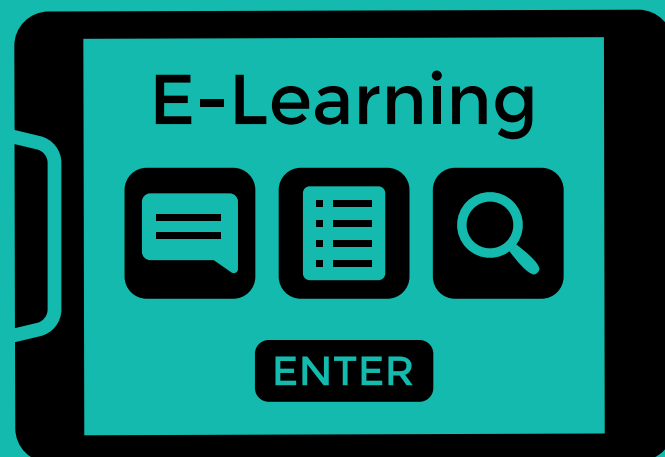

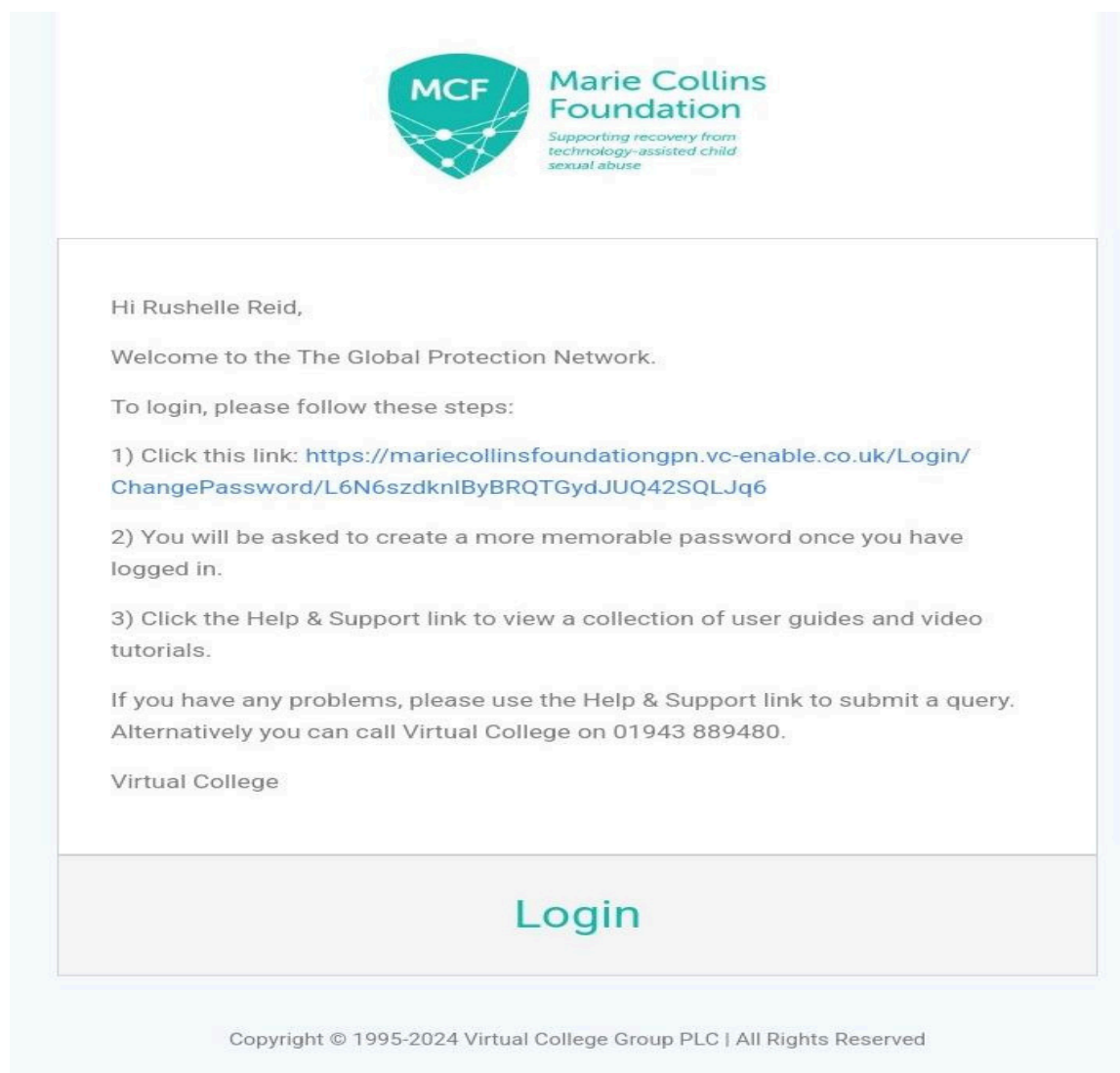

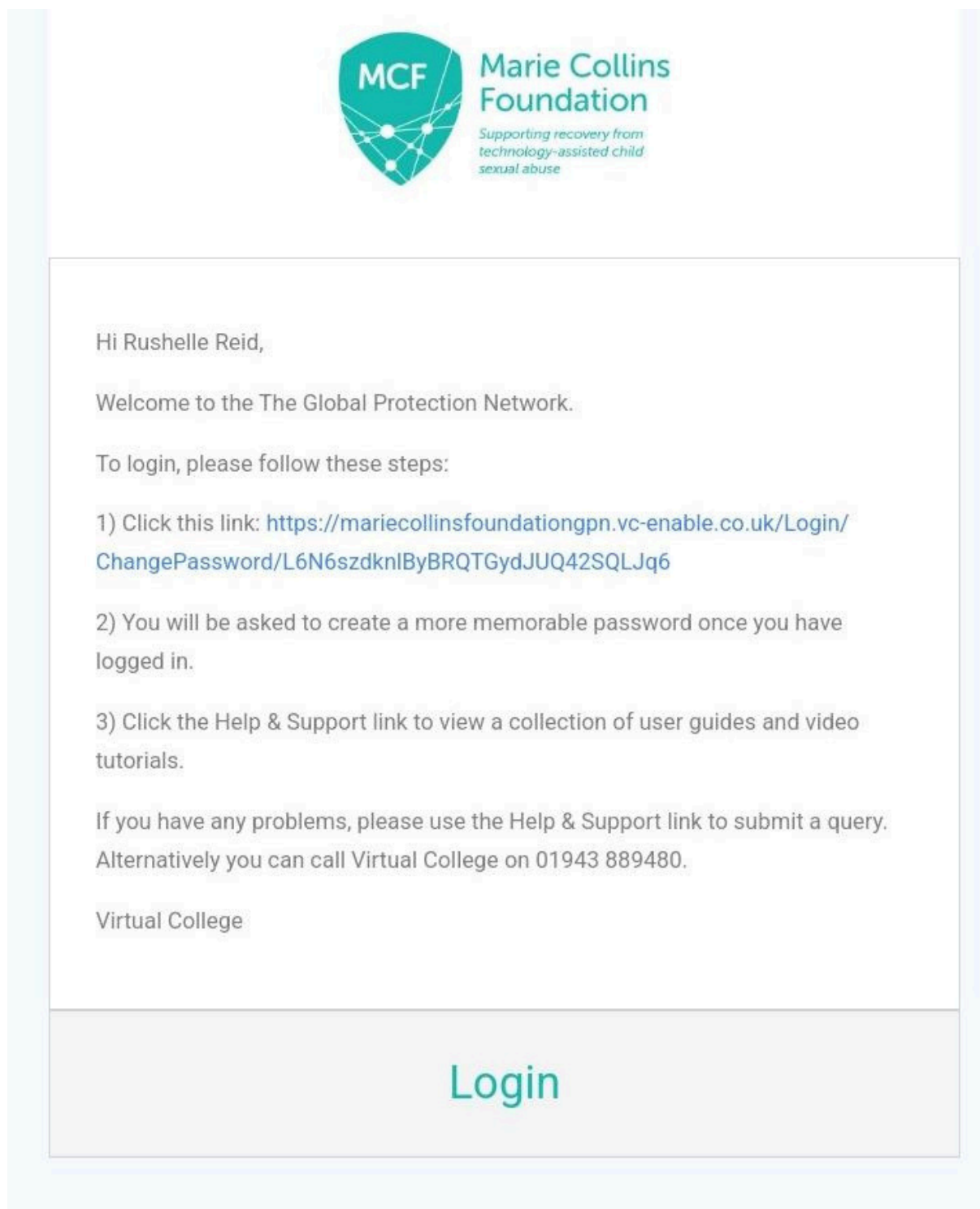
Registering for an account
